"For in hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what is seen? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience."

I am writing this newsletter article on the first official day of Spring. The house windows are open, letting in some fresh air. The smell is amazing! This time of year always makes me impatient. Impatient for the warm weather to last for more than a day. Impatient for the plants in my garden to pop through the ground. Impatient for no jackets and flip flops. Impatient for spending time outside. I find myself more impatient this year. It has been a long year of COVID 19 restrictions and precautions. So many things were cancelled last year, and I can't wait to make up for lost time. I'm just so ready for it to be over.

There is expectation that things will return to normal sooner rather than later. The vaccine is becoming available to more and more people. I got my first dose, and I can honestly say I have never been more excited to get a shot in my life! Getting the second dose will allow me to engage more in in-person ministry. I know that many of you are fully vaccinated already and have expressed how relieved you feel. Restrictions on gatherings and activities are being lifted or expanded. Care facilities are allowing visitors with guidelines. There is reason to hope.

But it isn't over yet. In early March (3/9), the number of active cases in Sheboygan County was down to 131 (lowest it has been since 8/2020), but there has been a continuous rise in active cases since then (as of 3/19 it was 172). Sheboygan County is still in the high mitigation range. Moving too quickly to return to "normal" can have the opposite effect of what we are hoping for. So, for now at Saron we will continue to follow the precautions that have been put in place to do our part to ensure the health of all of our congregation.

I know that singing has been one of the hardest things for us to give up. I reviewed the guidelines that have been shared with us about places of worship, talked to teachers about how they are handling singing in school, and looked at other materials that are out there about singing and its relationship to spreading COVID 19. I think we can safely (or as safe as anything is) resume singing one hymn each week as long as we mask up to do it. Masks will help contain the spreading of the aerosols.

I know this has been hard. I know we are ready for it to be over. I know it is hard to be patient. But as Paul wrote to those in the church in Rome, patience is necessary when we live in hope. And isn't that what being an Easter people is all about.

Septic System Project Update As Of February 28, 2021

As you will recall, in May 2020 we provided the congregation with a copy of the accepted bids from Schwartz Septic, Neumann Plumbing & Heating and KW Electric for replacement of the septic system. The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$44,406 (which includes an additional \$5,000 above bids for unforeseen expenses). Here is an update to the congregation on the progress that has been made in funding this project.

Estimated Cost of Project \$44,406.00

Less: Down payment for church & house holding tanks 5/21/20) (\$4,000.00)

Balance of Estimated Total Cost to be Paid to Vendors \$40,406.00

Improvement Fund (earmarked for project from fund balance) (\$1,000.00)

(\$5,000 less \$4,000 down payment paid 5/21/20)

Total member donations as of 2/28/2021 (\$12,495.00)

Balance needed for septic system project \$26,911.00

If you would like to contribute towards this project, please note in the memo section of your check "Septic System Project". As shown above, we have earmarked \$5,000 of the funds currently held in the Improvement Fund (\$46,136) for this project and would like to keep the balance for any unforeseen expenses that may arise. However, we will allocate additional funds, if necessary, in Spring 2021 when the balance comes due for the project. We are exploring a variety of fundraising options, however, in the current environment of COVID-19, we feel it would be best to hold off on any type of event until early 2021.
