Dear Ones,

By the time this arrives in your mail box, I will have been your interim minister for a month. It has been a lovely experience for me. Your caring attitudes for Saron Church reflect the very same open welcome you have extended to me. It is a pleasure to be among you and share with you the faith of Christ and his ministry. It is therefore, that a moment in time whose influence affects us as his disciples, is elevated and shared for our collective thoughts and prayers.

The tragic and all too, sorrowful event that took place at the AME Church in Charleston, SC has not gone unnoticed in Christian churches the world over. We bow our heads and speak our prayers for our brothers and sisters. Yet, it is not something that we then can put aside and forget. We must consider thoughtfully and prayerfully what leads to such atrocities in our land. So, what follows reflects upon how it is that prejudices enter our lives and become part of our thinking at times.

There's a song in the musical South Pacific that declares, "We must be carefully taught." It's a song with a message not unlike the hymns we sing. It is a message that has to do with biases and prejudices that warp our attitudes regarding people we discern as "different." Sometimes we take for granted that our thinking is unaffected by our mind set. Things are what they are. Some groups of people are lazy; another group is stubborn. Another group holds a higher standard of morals. You get the idea. We get to thinking that we're on the side of what's true, of what's real, and are discerning when it comes to making generalities that fit to a 'T' the group of people we're referring to.

For some of us the statement of Jesus ("The poor are always with us".) justifies a careless attitude about the poor. Trying to turn that statement into an attitude of disregard about them misrepresents our Lord's caring for the disenfranchised of the world. It must be considered that such careless attitudes simply but profoundly affect and perpetuate attitudes of indifference or scorn. We need to be careful about what attitudes we project if not to be conscious of offending some others (and some declare their attitudes represent the truth of the matter) but more importantly, such attitudes erode and in time, corrode the sinews of our souls. If we do not consider the "others" of our world as also belonging and loved of God, we diminish God's nature and constrict our world to "us" and "them."

It is of a certainly that I have not arrived at the pinnacle of having mastered biased attitudes. I have tried to be more selective in my judgments regarding laziness or stubbornness or entitlement to specific situations rather than with a broad brush include all people stemming from a particular instance. The fact of the matter is that no one group of people has a claim of being just one thing. And that is true for whatever group I identify with and those I don't. We live in a diverse world, and since God is the creator of this world of ours and all who are in it, I embrace the diversity among us.


