Pastor's Notes

"Let the little children come to me; do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs." (Mark 10:14b)

Every year we are asked to contribute to the Neighbors in Need (NIN) offering. Sometimes we hear about where the grants are going and the good they are doing in their communities. But often they are not in our area. This year is different!

Union Congregational UCC in Green Bay received a NIN grant for its On the Mark Dyslexia Clinic. I did not know that Wisconsin is one of only two states that does not require dyslexia instruction in public schools. The Clinic was opened in June of 2018 by Patricia Shafer, a retired teacher and member of Union. During the 2018 school year they served 28 students and the 2019 summer program had 54 students coming for one-on-one tutoring. Some of them traveled 40 miles to participate in the program.

While the Clinic is a separate program from the church, it is supported by the congregation in numerous ways. Financial support along with supply drives and volunteers to comply with their Safe Church policy are some of the ways the congregation supports the Clinic. "It's really a justice issue for these kids who aren't getting the instruction they need," Shafer said.

NIN offerings support the work of the UCC's Justice and Witness Ministries in three ways – direct service projects in the form of grants to local churches (like Union) and organizations, justice initiatives, and advocacy efforts. A third of the offering supports the UCC's Council for American Indian Ministries (CAIM). There are 20 UCC congregations on reservations and one urban, multi-tribe congregation in Minneapolis.

This year's NIN theme is Love of Children. Union has found a way to love the children in their community who were in need of a special service. Your gifts to NIN help support programs like this and others you can read about in the bulletin inserts and on-line at ucc.org/nin.

At Pilgrim Center, Green Lake, WI


Our theme will be Feasting with God: Feast of our Foremothers.

Neighbors in Need (NIN) is a special mission offering of the United Church of Christ that supports ministries of justice and compassion throughout the United States. One-third of NIN funds support the Council for American Indian Ministry (CAIM). Two-thirds of this offering is used by the UCC's Justice and Witness Ministries (JWM) to support a variety of justice initiatives, advocacy efforts, and direct service projects through grants. Neighbors in Need grants are



awarded to UCC churches and organizations doing justice work in their communities. These grants fund projects whose work ranges from direct service to community organizing and advocacy to address systemic injustice. This year, special consideration will be given to projects focusing on serving our immigrant neighbors and communities. Offering envelopes are in the pews.
