Pastor's Notes

I am a fan of all of those home renovation shows on HGTV. One of my favorites is Property Brothers. If you have never seen or heard of the show the basis of the show is that the Property Brothers will make the clients' dream home out of a home that in no way fits into that dream. As they tour the homes, the clients' faces show more and more disbelieve, but the Brothers get more and more excited as they articulate how different this house can look. While they see what is right before them, they can also see the possibilities of what can be. Jonathan, the contractor/designer of the duo, shares his vision for the home based on what the clients have told him they would like. Drawings of this vision are shared with us as well. But when the big reveal happens, there are always changes to that design and vision. Some of the changes result from the clients' tastes and input, others because of budget issues, and still others because of obstacles that are encountered along the way and modifications needing to be made.

It all starts with a vision, being able to see beyond what is right in front of them and being able to see what can be.


Youth News and Events
